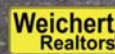

FROM YOUR PASTOR'S HEART

By now you have probably heard . . . that Highpoint Church has proposed adopting our church and serving together.

I shared with our church last Sunday this intriguing and exciting (and somewhat overwhelming) idea. Let me use this space to share in a printed form some of what I shared on Sunday.

Who is Highpoint? They are a strong church in the Memphis area – one church with multiple locations. They are a contemporary church (both in worship and their church model). Their vision is “we exist to prove LOVE WORKS!”

- They are listed as the **25th fastest growing church** in the country.
- They are affiliated with the the SBC and Mid-South Baptist. Both Chris Conlee (Lead Pastor) and Andy Savage (Teaching Pastor) graduated from Mid-America Seminary. Their statement of faith aligns perfectly with ours.

- They currently have three locations: Highpoint East, Highpoint Arlington and Highpoint Collierville. They are proposing a new site: **Highpoint Bartlett Hills.**

What does that mean? The two churches will become one. All members of Bartlett Hills would become members of Highpoint. We will work together to reach this community. We would benefit from all their programs and ministries.

- If this is approved, there would be TWO DIFFERENT WORSHIP SERVICES. Highpoint would offer their contemporary service. We would still have our “blended” service where Rusty and I will give leadership.
- We would work together in missions and ministries to serve as one.
- We would still have our Wednesday Night activities and lots of our current activities. Some would change because of overlap or becoming unnecessary.

We will be exploring and discussing with Highpoint over the next several weeks how this would all work.
